Energy markets are experiencing a bullish surge today, primarily driven by escalating geopolitical tensions in the Middle East, which have sent crude oil prices sharply higher. Shipping rates are also robust, with VLCC secondhand values at decade highs, while equities show mixed performance with tech stocks facing headwinds.
